

Join Together Festival Ticket Purchase – Terms & Conditions

Ticket Purchase and Policy

1. Join Together Festival 2026 will take place on Saturday, 4th July 2026.
2. All ticket sales are final – tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances.
3. Tickets for Join Together Festival will be available to purchase online until Friday 3rd July 2026 at 5pm.
4. Tickets can be purchased in advance online or on the day subject to availability. On the day tickets are purchasable only at the front entrance.
5. Free carer tickets for those accompanying a person with a disability cannot be pre-purchased but will be available at the event gates upon presentation of valid proof, such as a Blue Badge, Personal Independence Payment (PIP) letter, Disability Living Allowance (DLA) letter, or equivalent documentation.

Event Entry and Conduct

6. All attendees must present a valid ticket for entry.
7. The festival site has a strict no smoking or vaping policy. Vendors and attendees must not smoke or vape anywhere on the premises.
8. No animals are allowed onsite except for registered service animals.
9. Together Trust reserves the right to refuse entry or remove any attendee who is disruptive or does not comply with event rules.
10. Attendees must follow all health and safety guidelines in place at the venue.
11. Some areas of the event may have age restrictions; attendees under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult.

Event Changes and Cancellations

9. Together Trust reserves the right to alter the event schedule, lineup, or location due to unforeseen circumstances.
10. If the event is cancelled by Together Trust, ticket holders will be offered a full refund. No refunds will be issued for changes in event programming.

Liability

11. Together Trust is not responsible for any personal injury, loss, or damage to property during the event, except where required by law.
12. Attendees participate at their own risk and are responsible for their personal belongings.

Photography and Promotion

13. By attending, you agree that any photos or videos taken during the festival may be used for promotional purposes, unless you notify us in writing before the event.
